Minutes of the Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Lake George, NY, held on Monday, February 24, 2025 at 4:30 p.m. Zoom teleconferencing was also available.

At 4:30 p.m. Mayor Perry opened the Regular Meeting and asked Trustee Root to lead the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mayor Perry presented the minutes from the Special Workshop Meeting held on February 10, 2025.

Trustee Root made a motion, seconded by Trustee Mastrodomenico, carried unanimously to approve the minutes from the Special Workshop Meeting held on February 10, 2025.

MOTION PASSED.

Monthly reports from the Sanitation Department and Caldwell Sewer District, Fire Department, Superintendent of Public Works, REC Center, and Financial Reports were presented and made available to the public.

Mayor Perry asked Dan Barusch to present the NEXAMP proposal.

Dan Barusch explained that NEXAMP was a community solar program that the Village went out to bid for five years ago and set up the Village's small electric accounts on, with a pay as you go model. He said NEXAMP recently came back to him offering the Village and Town to sign their anchor (large) accounts which require a contract with a twenty-year term. He said that the Town did not agree to a twenty-year term with them. He said that the Town went back into negotiations with them and agreed to a fifteen-year term. Mr. Barusch suggested that the Village consider the same deal of fifteen years for their large accounts. He went on to explain that on average the savings were about eleven percent. He said with a twenty-year contract the savings would near almost \$1M. Mr. Barusch said that he would wait to hear back from the Village Board. He said that the Village is currently saving around \$40k per year with the current contract.

Trustee Root said that last year there was discussion regarding doing a consolidation or comprehensive study. He asked Mr. Barusch if he had any room on his plate to do one this year.

Mr. Barusch responded that generally speaking his plates were pretty full but if the Board wanted he could figure it out if either were to be forwarded or attempted to be started. He said his only suggestion was that with the comprehensive plan, some of what would end up on the comprehensive plan may be predicated on how the DRI money was spent and how some of the

projects came out. He said that if the Board determines they want the comprehensive study done first, they should wait until they achieve some completion of the DRI. Mr. Barusch said that the consolidation study could be done whenever they want as the grant available to fund it was a rolling grant, so it was available numerous times a year. He said that the smart growth grant available for the comprehensive plan was only available from May until July so if it didn't happen prior to July they would need to wait until the following year.

Trustee Root asked if the tax incentive was still in place for the consolidation study. Mr. Barusch responded that it was still available and that the likelihood of that program ever going away was very slim. He said that even during Covid, they offered incentive.

Mayor Perry presented the correspondence received. He said there was a letter from the LGA with the updated dates for the Rec Center program. The next letter was a request for financial support from the Lake George Jr.-Sr, High School for the Junior prom. The Mayor explained that the Village could not offer financial support. The Mayor then presented the Water report results from the Department of Health for the public's review. Mayor Perry presented a second notice received from Robert Blais regarding flooding that occurs on his property. Mayor Perry said that Water and Soil looked at the scenario and that they had offered to gift materials to help rectify the issue this Spring.

Mayor Perry presented resolutions for consideration to the Board.

Trustee Miller said she felt if they did not limit accrual, it could potentially be large payouts that were not budgeted. Trustee Miller also said that she felt limiting accrual would urge employees to use their vacation time, and that vacation time is beneficial to employee well-being. Clerk Allen asked that the Trustees look in depth at the policy and come up with suggestions to help improve the current policy.
