- D. Does not interfere with flow of pedestrians, obstruct views or egress to vehicles or other storefronts.
- E. Contains no advertising, letters, or numbers. If part of village-wide promotion may contain a sponsor's name.
- F. No similar item may be for sale on the interior of the premises.
- G. Must be approved, in advance, by the Village Board.

The undersigned agrees to accept full responsibility for any damage or wear to the object and to hold the Village harmless for any claims arising out of the use of the object(s).
