WHEREAS, in July of 2024, the amphitheater located in Shepard Park in the Village of

Lake George, Warren County, New York, (the "Village") was destroyed by a fire; and

WHEREAS, since that time the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village have pursued funding for the removal and replacement of the Shepard Park amphitheater which may include grant funding, insurance proceeds, and Village funds; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees retained an architect and engineers to prepare plans and specifications for the reconstruction of the Shepard Park amphitheater which will include physical replacement of the structure and associated plumbing, wiring, sound systems, fixtures, furnishings and similar improvements (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, as of the date of this resolution the Village has secured funding including \$1,900,000.00 from the Downtown Revitalization Initiative (DRI), and \$2,900,000.00 from the Dormitory Authority of the State of New York (DASNY); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees completed a coordinated review of the Project in accordance with the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") and properly issued a negative declaration thereon, by resolution of the Board of Trustees dated July 21, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the Village's architect has provided an opinion of probable cost for the Project, a copy of which is attached to this resolution, which totals \$4,400,000.00 dated July 25, 2025 by the Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees desires to authorize the Project at a maximum cost of \$4,400,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Board of Trustees hereby authorizes the Project at a total maximum Project cost of \$4,400,000.00 for the Project to be paid for by insurance proceeds and grant funds; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the remaining cost of the Project will be paid by the appropriation of proceeds from the fund balance and/or other funds of the Village by resolution of the Board of

Trustees; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or Deputy Mayor in his absence, be and hereby are authorized to execute any and all documents and to take such other and further action as he or she may deem appropriate and necessary relative to this resolution; and be it further

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall take effect immediately.
