Doug/Carol suggested the banner be installed where the sign is currently located and the sign be put on the inside of the window. This remedy was not done and the sign remains up. MAYOR'S MEMO DATED JULY 19, 2011

The Mayor has asked the Board to review and comment on the section of the proposed LED law that relates to electronic interior signs. The Village Board has rejected the idea that electronic interior signs must be set back 3 feet. Also, the proposed law allowed for only one electronic window sign. The Board feels the use of electronic window signs should be limited to an amount of square footage just as other signs have been limited to 35% of the window area. The Village Board has agreed to limit the size to 5 square feet and that electronic window signs can only operate during business hours.
